## **Points**

- *Points will be tracked & posted online throughout the year*
- *Points awarded to top 3 horse/rider combinations in each of the above classes at each show:*

### **Eventing Classes**

#### Combined Tests

*First Place – 3 points*

*Second Place – 2 points*

*Third Place – 1 point*

#### 3-Phase

*First Place – 4 points*

*Second Place – 3 points*

*Third Place – 2 points*

### **Dressage Only Classes**

*First Place – 3 points*

*Second Place – 2 points*

*Third Place – 1 point*

## **Rules/qualifications**

- *Points are awarded to horse-rider combinations.*
- *Riders can accrue points at more than one level throughout the year. Points from different levels do not combine. For example, a rider can accrue points at Novice & Training throughout the year, but the points stay at that level.*
- *If a horse-rider combination competes in both the CT & 3-phase at the same level throughout the year, those points will combine for their total number of points at that level. However, you do earn more points for placing in a 3-phase than a CT.*
- *Points accrued in Training/Novice 3-Phase classes will be applied to the Novice division*

## **Year-End Awards**

- *Awards ceremony to take place during Poplar Place Appreciation Day on Sunday December 17, 2017 following the Saturday December 16, 2017 Schooling Show.*
- *Ties will be broken using the final score from the show date when the last points were earned for each competitor. For eventing divisions, the rider with the lowest score from their most recent show will win. For dressage divisions, the rider with the highest score (average score, if more than 1 test at that level) will win.*
- *Winners will be announced 1 week following the final qualifying 2017 Schooling Show*
- *PPF Gift Certificates can be applied to future show entries, PPF merchandise, or schooling fees.*
