



COVID-19 Safety Protocol:

-Participants must comply with social distancing requirements as regulated by state and/or local authorities, including the most current recommendations regarding the wearing of face masks when in groups of people, and when a 6-foot distance cannot be sustained. Face masks do not need to be worn when mounted on a horse.

-Regularly sanitize golf carts, door handles, stall latches, light switches and equipment in your barn area including tack, grooming, feeding, and stall cleaning materials etc.

-Disinfect surfaces and items in common areas after each use.

-In the event of inclement weather, plan to shelter in your vehicle

-Each barn should bring the same materials and use the same operating protocols that you have implemented in your private barn operation since the COVID-19 pandemic started. Hand sanitizing stations are located throughout the property and soap is provided for hand washing in restrooms and wash stalls.

-All officials, competitors and volunteers must sign the new release forms. Spectators are not allowed at this time and please limit the number of people accompanying the competitor.
