Class details and general information

➤ **Entries:**

- With each entry, include:
 - 1) Entry form.
 - 2) Payment.
 - 3) Coggins, if not on file.
 - 4) Poplar Place Farm Release, if not on file.
 - 5) GDCTA Release, if not on file.
- **Accepted entries will be held responsible for all fees.**

➤ **Electronic entries:** e1.evententries.com

➤ **Change Fee:** \$10 for any changes after entry submitted (e.g., rider or horse change, class change, etc.)

➤ **Late Entry Fee:**

- A late entry is an entry postmarked or received after closing date - must include a \$25 late fee and full payment
- Late entries accepted up until midnight on the Tuesday prior to the show - if space allows.

➤ **Coggins:** Negative Coggins within 12 months required for all horses

➤ **Payment:**

- Payment is due when entry is submitted.
- Fax or email entries must include credit card information.
- Checks payable to Poplar Place Farm – any returned checks will incur a \$25 returned check fee
- We accept VISA, MasterCard, Amex and Discover
- Credit card information provided will be used to settle any balance on the account after the completion of the show
- Any unpaid fees will be applied to your next entry

➤ **Refunds/Scratched entry:**

- Scratches must be received in writing (fax, email, or text) - No voicemail withdrawals accepted.
- Before closing date - Full refund less office fee
- After closing date – Full refund less office fee & half of all class fees
- Thursday & Friday prior to show - no refund, but may receive a schooling voucher upon request
- **Day of show – no refunds for any reason**
- Poplar Place will issue refund checks within 7-10 business days from the event
- Inclement weather – PPF will advise competitors of changes to refund policies as warranted

➤ **Stabling:**

- Stall: \$50 per night, INCLUDES 1 bag of shavings.
- Tack Stall: \$25 per night, no shavings.
- Stabling change requests will be accepted up until Wednesday at midnight prior to the show – no changes or refunds for unused stabling after that
- Please strip your stall before leaving or sign up for stall clean-out for \$20

➤ **Haul-In Fee:** If not stabling, \$20 per day

- **Shavings:** \$8 per bag pre-order & \$10 per bag on-site purchase
- **Non-competing Horses:** \$20 Grounds Fee, either a stall fee or haul-in fee, and office fee.
- **RV/Camper Spots:**
 - \$50 per day for 110V-20amp
 - \$50 per day for 220V-30/50amp
 - Includes overnight, water and electric
 - Number of RV Hookups are limited. Assigned by postmark date
- **Check-In:** The office will open at 12 noon Friday before the show for check-in.
- **Ride Times:**
 - Available Thursday PM before the show on website – www.poplarplacefarm.com
 - FINAL ride times will be posted the Friday prior to the show at 7:00 PM Eastern – no changes will be made after that time
- **Dressage Tests – Arena Size**
 - Introductory Level – Small Arena (20x40)
 - Training Level and Up – Standard Arena (20x60)
 - Eventing Tests
 - Pre-Amoeba thru Preliminary A – Small Arena (20x40)
 - Preliminary B, Intermediate, Advance, & FEI Tests – Standard Arena (20x60)
- **Calling Tests:** Intro thru Fourth Level may be called. All CT/3-Phase Tests may be called.
- **Combined Tests**
 - Includes Dressage and Show Jumping
 - Pre-Amoeba – USDF Intro Test A
 - Amoeba – USDF Intro Test B
 - Tadpole – USDF Intro Test C
 - Starter – USEF Starter Test
 - Beginner Novice thru Prelim. - USEF Eventing Test A
 - Show Jumping: Pre-Amoeba – 12”; Amoeba – 18”; Tadpole – 2’; Starter – 2’3”; Beginner Novice 2’6”; Novice – 2’11”; Training – 3’ 3”; Modified 3’5”; Preliminary 3’ 7”
- **3-Phase**
 - Amoeba – USDF Intro Test B; Show Jumping – 18”; XC -12”, N/A.
 - Tadpole – USDF Intro Test C; Show Jumping – 2’; XC – 2’ at 300 mpm.
 - Starter – USEF Starter Test; Show Jumping – 2’3”; XC – 2’ at 300 mpm.
 - Beginner Novice – USEF Beginner Novice Test A; Show Jumping – 2’6”; XC- 2’6” at 325 mpm.
 - Novice – USEF Novice Test A; Show Jumping – 2’11”; XC – 2’11” at 400 mpm.
 - Training Novice – USEF Training Test A; Show Jumping – 3’3”; XC - 2’11” at 400 mpm.
 - Training – USEF Training Test A; Show Jumping – 3’3”; XC – 3’3” at 450 mpm.
 - Modified Training – USEF Modified Test A; Show Jumping – 3’5”; XC – 3’3” at 450 mpm.
 - Includes one XC Schooling before the event ONLY - if you do not use the XC schooling before the event, you DO NOT get a credit for it and are NOT ALLOWED to use it after the event.
- **Eliminations:**

- CT and 3-phase competitors – if eliminated, competitor may be given permission by the office to continue in the next phase upon request and barring no safety issues.
- **Time Penalties:**
 - Stadium for 3-phase and CT classes ONLY:
 - Amoeba classes are timed, but no penalties will be added
 - All other classes, 1 points per second over optimum time will be added
 - Cross Country
 - Amoeba division is timed, but no penalties will be added
 - All other divisions, 0.4 points per second over optimum time will be added
 - Beginner Novice – Training, 0.4 points per second under optimum time will be added
- **Show Jumping Scoring:**
 - SJ 12” crossrails, 12” and 18”
 - Scored based on faults incurred over the course and elapsed time
 - Time penalties will not be assessed
 - Ties will not be broken
 - Reference Table II, Sec 1 (modified)
 - All SJ classes 2’ and above
 - Scored by adding together faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed
 - Ties in faults will be broken on the following basis: an “Optimum Time” (defined as 4 seconds less than the Time Allowed for the course) will be posted on the course plan; the horse with the time on course closest to this Optimum Time (over or under) will prevail in the tie, next closest next, etc.
 - Reference Table IV, Sec 1
- **Cross-Country Schooling:**
 - Amoeba thru Training XC jumps.
 - May ride Friday after 12pm prior to the start of the show.
- **Show Jump Schooling:**
 - Opens at 2 pm on Friday and will close at 6PM
 - Allowed two rounds of schooling in show jumping arena
 - Must sign-in with the steward at the arena
- **Ribbons:**
 - Ribbons are awarded thru 6th place for each class. Ribbons are available in the show office. Medals awarded 1st-3rd place for Poplar Place Dressage Seat Equitation class.
- **Lunging:**
 - No lunging in any of the arenas. Lunging permitted in the grass “lunging area,” located across the driveway from the show jumping arena along the tree line
